The “Journey” series was created more than twenty years ago by author Richard Pelzer and was only recently released for publication as a result of the author’s ability to finally talk about the real life of the Daly City, California Pelzer family. A previous publication entitled “A Child Called IT” (Health Communications 1996) partially describes one of the most abusive households in California’s history.

Author Richard Pelzer has been secured by several organizations as a quest speaker of child abuse prevention and awareness. Scheduled for fundraisers in several states, Pelzer prioritizes State and Federal Child welfare and Protective Services, public and private schools and non-profit organizations designed to assist young children to seek and obtain guidance throughout the country and organizations internationally.

Pelzer created a privately held corporation in 2004 with the goal of assisting teens, young adults and young parents find solutions and resources for child abuse prevention and awareness. Born in 1965 in Daly City California Richard Pelzer was one of five boys who lived the nightmare of child abuse that the world later learned of in the acclaimed book “A Child Called IT” written by one of Richard’s brothers.

horrific life lead by the Pelzer family in the 1970's. Richard Pelzer completes the missing pieces with the "Journey" series and provides the rest of the story.
