The program is in several sections and will include:

a) A children's musical production, called "The Husky Gang Show," conceived, written and composed by Phyllis Sdoia-Satz and illustrated by Christopher Mangiaracina.

b) An interactive story-telling event about the Adventures of the Husky Gang.

c) An interactive music teaching event where the Husky Gang characters will teach the young children in the audience the basics of music by singing songs.
