Heather is now recording her new album titled “the goddess within” with Rich Balmer, a 5 time Grammy nominated producer in Los Angeles. Her executive

producer is Ed Bennett, the founder of VH1.

A graduate of Boston University's classical music program, Heather possesses a mind-blowing 3 1/2 octave range. She learned piano and performed throughout New England as a lyric soprano soloist. Her potential in the classical field was evident – she won competitions and traveled in Europe as a soloist; however, Heather wanted to find a bigger audience. The very same weekend she graduated as a promising opera singer, she impetuously set out for Las Vegas, the host city of the Miss Millennium pageant. Expecting a fun weekend, perhaps an interesting learning experience, she walked out with a title, besting 199 talented peers. Becoming Miss Millennium 2002 was a turning point in Heather's life. This event ended up being the catalyst that incited her current career path.
