

A New Twist In An Old Healing Dance

This type of homeopathic remedy is classified as a “nosode” according to the FDA and is available by prescription only. Nosodes are created from the diseased tissue of an organism using the basic homeopathic principle of “like treating like.” The history of this practice stems from 1830 when Constantine Hering was the first to consider the use of nosodes.

While testing is underway to determine the exact mechanism of action of CarcinPLUS(TM), early results in both humans and animals suggest the remedy may provide some positive effects for a wide variety of conditions. In addition, the website provides links to published references describing the known effects of the supplements being taken by the CarcinPLUS(TM) donor, which may account for the early positive results being observed in those using the remedy.

Recent studies on similar homeopathic remedies have reported impressive results in both preventing and treating cancers. A 2005 study published in the Journal of Alternative and Complementary Medicine on Carcinodin, also a nosode created from breast cancer tissue, demonstrated that when administered orally to mice chronically fed a carcinogenic agent that induces liver cancer, the remedy provided antitumor, anticlastogenic, and anticytotoxic effects.

A 2003 article in the International Journal of Oncology on one of the supplements taken by the CarcinPLUS donor was conducted at M.D. Anderson Cancer Center in Texas and also at a homeopathic clinic in India. In this study, 6 of the 7 glioma [brain cancer] patients showed complete regression of tumors. Both in vivo and in vitro results showed induction of survival-signaling pathways in normal lymphocytes and induction of death-signaling pathways in brain cancer cells.

In the United States about 20 million to 30 million people use homeopathic remedies, according to Peter Gold, communications director of the National Center for Homeopathy in Alexandria, Va., “Worldwide, the number is staggering,” he says. “In Europe alone, 40 percent to 50 percent of consumers use them.” (Progressive Grocer, Dec. 2005). One of the most pervasive reasons for the boom in homeopathy and other alternative products is that consumers have indicated their desire for health care solutions that are less intrusive, have fewer side effects, and are more focused on prevention.
