He served as Chairman of EPRI’s Power Delivery Reliability Initiative and Vice Chairman of Edison Electric Institute’s (EEI) Transmission and Distribution Committee. Mr. Donohue has a BEE from City College of New York and attended the Penn State University Executive Program.
