

Virtual Star Search Contest Provides Forum to Showcase Talent and Get Discovered

Only registered members can vote. Registration also provides access to discussion boards, chat rooms and teleseminars.

Voting will take place July 15th through August 15th. Each week, six people will be eliminated until one winner is left in each category. The top winner in each category will be announced no later than September 1st.

This is TheTalentQuest.com’s premiere. Contests will be ongoing and a new one will begin every four months; the second one is scheduled to run September

through December and continuously thereafter.

“To encourage participation,” Debs explained, “people 18 years or older can register to win cash and prizes ranging from \$100 to \$1,000 when visiting the site. Drawings will be held monthly.”
