Hvorostovsky also is a celebrated recitalist and has performed in the world's major international recital venues, including the Wigmore Hall, London, Queen's Hall, Edinburgh, Carnegie Hall, New York, the Teatro alla Scala, Milan, the Tchaikovsky Conservatoire, Moscow, the Liceu, Barcelona, the Suntory Hall Tokyo and the Musikverein, Vienna. He also has given recitals in Istanbul, Jerusalem, Australia, South America and across the Far East.
