

/*CORRECTION*/ A Permanent Green Art Installation by Marta Thoma Hall is in the New Walnut Creek Library Opening July 17th

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. (SEND2PRESS NEWSWIRE) – In a press release issued June 22 on behalf of Marta Thoma Hall, there was an inadvertent error in specifying the date of the event, as provided by the news source. Is it supposed to represent a galaxy? What do the arrows mean?
