

iFOS is Seeking External Application Reviewers for CDFI Fund and NMTC Programs for Fiscal Year 2013

- Must be able to dedicate at least 20 hours per week to application reviews for 3-6 weeks review period;
- High speed internet access is required.

Education and Experience Qualifications:

- Minimum of Bachelor's degree in Finance, Public or Business Administration, Economics, Urban Planning and Development, or related field;
- 5+years expertise in community and economic development finance;
- Experience working in and/or with low income and underserved communities;
- Experience analyzing financial statements;
- Experience performing underwriting of loans and/or investments;
- Prior experience with evaluating CDFI Fund and/or Native American CDFI Assistance (NACA), and New Market Tax Credit (NMTC) Program applications preferred;
- Experience with Microsoft Word, Excel and PowerPoint.

Reviewer Stipend: Incentives to earn up to \$175 per reviewer assignment.

The subsequent cutoff for the review and acceptance of applications is Friday, March 29, 2013 by 5 p.m. ET.
