The [three-day course](#) has been specifically developed to educate attendees on [current topics](#) pertaining to the practice of foot and ankle surgery. Attendees will also participate in industry sessions presented by the course sponsors. Attendees will rotate through the exhibit hall in small groups, meeting and interacting with each course sponsor. Course Completion Certificates will be handed out upon conclusion of the course.

The course will be hosted at the History Colorado Museum and is exclusive to foot and ankle fellows, final year residents, and young surgeons within their first three years of practice.
